Facebook Violations—Abusers often use social media to harass and shame their victims. Learn steps you can take to protect yourself on Facebook.

What is a Facebook Violation?

Some examples of Facebook violations include hacked accounts (when someone takes over your account without your permission), threatening posts and messages, and inappropriate photos.

Even if you don't have account or you can't get into your account, there are forms you can submit to Facebook!

How to Report a Violation on Facebook

Step-By-Step Reporting:

- Select **Help** on the main Facebook page.
- Select **Report Something**.
- Select **Report a Violation**.

After You Report

- You can see the status of your report on the **Support Dashboard** that appears under the **Privacy Settings** link, if you have access to your account.
- The **Support Dashboard** will show you if and when your report is received, and what actions the Facebook security team is taking.
- Facebook also has "**Learn More**" links where you can learn why action was or was not taken after you submitted a report.
